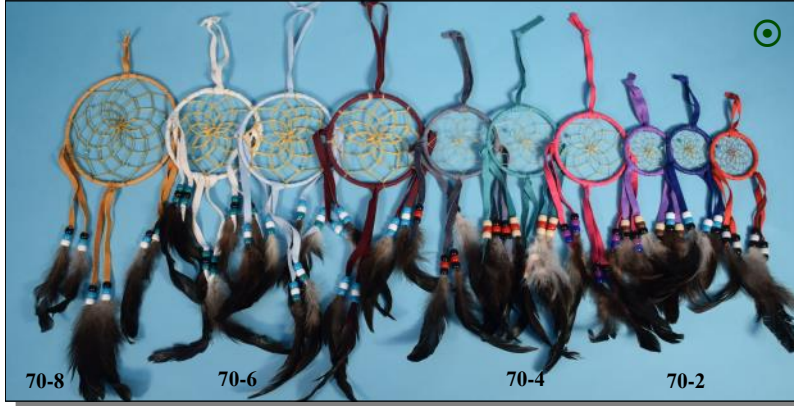


1020-1 Navajo Dream Catchers & Medicine Wheels

NAVAJO DREAM CATCHERS



These Navajo Dream Catchers are made by Navajo artist Mae Stone and her assistants in New Mexico. They are trimmed with pig skin leather and chicken feathers. The fancy dream catchers have turkey feathers. Each dream catcher comes with a card describing the legend and guaranteeing its authenticity.

We offer the Dream Catchers with either plastic beads or glass beads. (Pig: *Sus scrofa domestica*; Turkey: *Meleagris gallopavo*).

70-FxP

In the middle of each Fancy Dream Catcher is a stone or obsidian arrowhead, a piece of hairpipe, a turquoise chip, and a silver bead.



70-H5P

The Half Moon is a 5" dream catcher covered partially by leather with a concho.



70-D6G

The Duet consists of a 2" dream catcher inside a 6" dream catcher.



70-T5P

The Triplet consists of three dream catchers (5", 4", and 3") joined by a piece of hairpipe.

NAVAJO MEDICINE WHEELS

The Navajo Medicine Wheels are made with assorted colors of leather, bone hairpipe, tin cones, feathers, and an abalone button. They come with a Certificate of Authenticity and card describing the significance of the Medicine Wheel (shown right). (Abalone button: *Halotis fulgens*; Bone Hairpipe: *Bubalus bubalis*; Cow Leather: *Bos taurus*).

Is round to represent the circle of life. The cross in the center represents the four winds, four seasons, four directions, and four grandfathers (teachers). Traditionally, eagle feathers were used, but being sacred, are not sold. The Wheels are strong medicine.

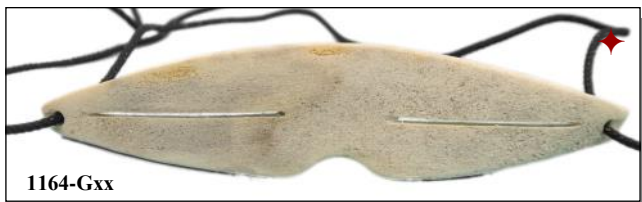

IROQUOIS TALKING STICKS

420-AS



The Iroquois talking sticks measure approximately two feet long and come with the card shown. Materials used include: deer antler, deerskin, feathers, glass beads, trade cloth, and rabbit fur. Each piece is unique. Made by Ramon Mitten (Six Nations, Seneca band 1503), an Iroquois artist in upstate New York. (Deer: *Odocoileus virginianus*; Rabbit: *Oryctolagus cuniculus*).

IROQUOIS TALKING STICK

The Talking Stick has been used by many different tribes in order to give the speaker the power to talk freely and to have an attentive audience. Whoever held the talking stick could talk without interruption and whatever was said by the person holding the talking stick could not be repeated outside of the circle.

This talking stick was made with pride in the USA by Ramon Mitten, Seneca Band, Six Nations.

NAVAJO STONE TOMAHAWKS

The stone tomahawks are wrapped pig skin leather and cow rawhide sinew and are decorated with horse hair and size 11 glass beads wrapped around the middle. The tomahawk measures 5½" to 6" long with a stone that is 1" to 1½" wide. (Cow: *Bos taurus*, Ranch; Pig: *Sus scrofa*, Ranch; Horse: *Equus caballus*, Ranch).

NAVAJO SPIRIT STICKS

The dreamcatcher spirit sticks are wrapped in pig skin leather and cow rawhide sinew and are decorated with horse hair and size 11 glass beads wrapped around the middle. They come in assorted colors. The dreamcatcher spirit stick measures 8" to 8½" long with a dreamcatcher that is 2" wide. (Cow: *Bos taurus*, Ranch; Pig: *Sus scrofa*, Ranch; Horse: *Equus caballus*, Ranch).
