IROQUOIS COYOTE CLAW NECKLACES



These REAL coyote claw necklaces are assembled from non-Native components by Karen Mitten (Cayuga 435), an Iroquois artist in upstate New York, using real coyote claws, antiqued brass beads, and a 32" deerskin neckstrap. (Deerskin: *Odocoileus virginianus*, wild; Coyote Claw: *Canis latrans*, wild).

IROQUOIS BADGER CLAW NECKLACES

These REAL badger claw necklaces are assembled from non-Native components by Karen Mitten (Cayuga 435), an Iroquois artist in upstate New York, using real badger claws, antiqued brass beads, and a 32" deerskin neckstrap. (Deerskin: *Odocoileus virginianus*, wild; Badger Claw: *Taxidea taxus*, wild).

IROQUOIS REALISTIC CLAW NECKLACES



The claws are made from quality plastic resin and are hand-painted in the USA. The realistic claws look so real that they have even fooled conservation officers and Native artists working with real bear claws! The necklaces come on a 32" deerskin neckstrap with a glass bead for the single claws and antiqued brass beads for the multi-claws. These necklaces are assembled from non-Native components by Karen Mitten (Cayuga 435), an Iroquois artist in upstate New York. They are accompanied by a card describing the animal from which they originate. (*Odocoileus virginianus*, wild).

IROQUOIS REALISTIC TOOTH NECKLACES

The bear teeth are made from quality plastic resin and are hand-painted in the USA. The necklaces come on a 32" deerskin neckstrap with a glass bead. These necklaces are assembled from non-Native components by Karen Mitten (Cayuga 435), an Iroquois artist in upstate New York. They are accompanied by a card describing the animal from which they originate. (*Odocoileus virginianus*, wild).

Each necklace comes bagged with a card describing how Native Americans used arrowheads to obtain food, shelter, and clothing. These necklaces are assembled from non-Native components by Karen Mitten (Cayuga 435), an Iroquois artist in upstate New York. (*Odocoileus virginianus*).

The mini bone pendants hang on a 21" to 23" waxed cotton cord with water buffalo hairpipe and silver-plated beads. The pendants and hairpipe have been tea-stained for an antiqued look. (*Bubalus bubalis*).

IROQUOIS DEER ANTLER TIP NECKLACES



The Antler Tip Necklace is decorated with a glass bead on a 32" deerskin neck strap. Antler tips range from 1" to 4" long. The beads are different colors. The necklaces come with an authenticity card that describes the importance of the deer to Native Americans. These necklaces are assembled from non-Native components by Karen Mitten (Cayuga 435), an Iroquois artist in upstate New York. (*Odocoileus virginianus*).

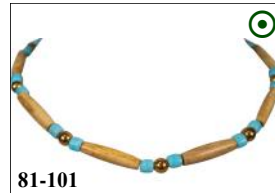

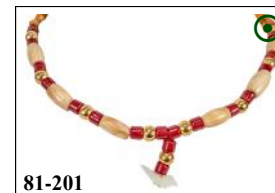

TRADITIONAL IROQUOIS BONE ANKLETS



These traditional Iroquois 2-row bone ankle bracelets are made with deerskin leather, water buffalo bone hairpipe, brass, and glass beads. The beads come in blue, red, and turquoise or we can send you assorted colors. The anklet strap is adjustable from 8" to 12" long. They are 1/2" wide. These anklets are made by Iroquois women on the Six Nations Reservation in Ontario, Canada. (*Bubalus bubalis, ranch; Odocoileus virginianus, wild*).

The bone pendants hang on a 28" to 33" long cow split neck strap with water buffalo hairpipe and silver-plated beads. The pendants and hairpipe have been tea-stained for an antiqued look. These necklaces are assembled from non-Native components by Iroquoian artisans in Canada. (*Bos taurus, ranch. Bubalus bubalis, ranch*).
