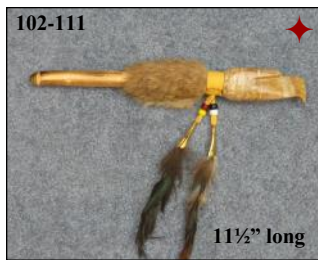


# 1040-1 Native American Pipes

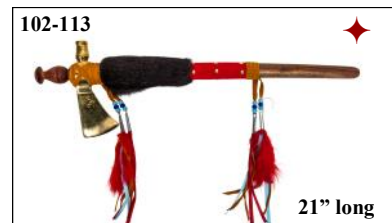
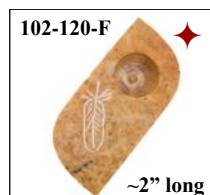
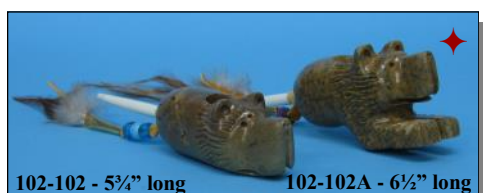

# 1040-2 Native-Made Rattles & Pipes

## NAVAJO RAWHIDE RATTLES

The Plain, Petroglyph and Drum styles are made by Native artisans from New Mexico or Arizona. They come with a card and description and photo of the artist. The authenticity card comes with each rattle.

The **Plain** style of rattles are made with cow rawhide, and are decorated with seed beads, horse hair and sinew. They are mounted on wooden dowels wrapped in antiques pigskin. They measure 2" x 2" x 1½" in size, with a 6" long by ½" wide handle.

The **Petroglyph** style of rattles are made with cow rawhide, and are mounted on wooden dowels wrapped in antiques pigskin. They are decorated with horse hair and sinew, and have different painted designs. These rattles measure 2¼" x 2¼" x 1½" in size, with an 8" long by ½" wide handle.

The **Drum** style of rattles are made with goat rawhide and sinew, and decorated with seed beads and horse hair. They are mounted on wooden dowels wrapped in antiques pigskin, and measure 2" x 1¾" x 1½" in size, with a 6¾" long by ½" wide handle. (Cow: *Bos taurus*; Goat: *Capra hircus*; Pig: *Sus scrofa*; Horse: *Equus caballus*).

The **Painted Ball** style of rattles are made using a painted ping pong ball and a wooden dowel wrapped in pig skin leather with cow rawhide sinew and a bit of horse hair. They come in assorted colors and designs. The painted ball rattles measure 6" to 7" long with a ball that is 1½" wide. (Cow: *Bos taurus*. Ranch; Pig: *Sus scrofa*. Ranch; Horse: *Equus caballus*. Ranch).

## NAVAJO ANTLER PIPES

These antler pipes are made by the Navajo. The pipe bowls are mostly carved from deer antler or occasionally elk antler. They have copper stems, a wood bead mouthpiece, and a jute strap. They are decorated with deerskin leather, turkey fluff feathers, wrapped decorated glass beads, and trim beads of bone, horn, or brass. They are 7" long, ½" wide, and 1½" to 2" tall. They weigh 1.8 oz. (White Tail Deer: *Odocoileus virginianus*, Mule Deer: *Odocoileus hemionus*, Elk: *Cervus elaphus*, Turkey: *Meleagris gallopavo*).
