## TOMAHAWK PIPES



These pipes are made to look like tomahawks and come in different styles and sizes. They are made wholly from brass or aluminum. Some styles have a teak wood handle. The large pipes measure about 18 " long with 6 " to $8^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ heads. The mini pipes measure between $71 / 2$ " and $101 / 2$ " long with $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " to $31 / 2 "$ heads. The heads may come plain or with designs
