FOX SKINS

In general, the foxes are cased (i.e., not split open). They usually measure about 2 to 3 feet in body length and have a tail that is about one foot long for a total of 3 to 4 feet. Please note that the measurements shown for each type of fox are based on the average size of some foxes that we had in the past and, as with any natural product, there will be variation in size within each species. Ranch-raised foxes can be significantly bigger than wild ones.



Arctic Foxes measure about 29" from the tip of the nose to the base of the tail. They are usually cased. Our taxidermy quality fox skins are rare and are suitable for lifesize mounts. (*Vulpes lagopus, wild*).
