# **COYOTE FUR SCRAP**

This scrap is a by-product of the fashion industry and does NOT contain faces and tails, which are sold separately. The scrap is all natural colors (i.e., not dyed). The **small pieces** can be as small as 1" by 1" and are usually not more than about six square inches. The leg and flank scrap is a mix of legs which have shorter and dense fur and of sides and flanks. The legs and flanks are usually long, thin strips. The premium scrap comes from the center of the back and has long, dense fur. This is called grutz or ridge scrap in the fashion industry. (Canis latrans, wild).
